Homework

Homework will be sent home weekly, and will include nightly reading, math and language arts review, as well as projects. Homework packets will be given on Fridays, and are due the following Friday. Long-term assignments, like book reports will have periodic checks to monitor progress.

Planners have been provided to keep track of homework and daily assignments. Students will have time in class to write their assignments neatly in their planners.

Students with excused absences will have the same number of days they were absent to finish their missed assignments. For example, if a student is absent for five days, they will have five days to complete their assignments. Any assignments given before the absence are due the day the student returns. Students are responsible for completing any tests they miss due to absences at recess or lunch.

Grading
